Creating an audiobook with Findawayvoices

Getting started

If you want to create an audiobook that is available through suppliers like Spotify, you can do so by using Findawayvoices.com. It begins, as usual, by creating an account. Apart from personal information (including your real name, which you also use as an author) you need to enter some financial information:

You need to fill in an American tax form, which will usually be the W-8BEN for non-USA citizens and organisations. Note that this is a legal document which should contain the correct information about your tax status; details from the USA IRS can be found on https://www.irs.gov/instructions/iw8ben. Here is some more information: https://www.investopedia.com/terms/w/w8form.asp

The bank details for the account on which you want to receive any proceeds should include the IBAN and the City of the bank (City) which is sometimes a bit harder to find. For individuals you enter your Tax identification number (for the Netherlands this is the Citizen service number or BSN); if your bank account is a company account you should enter the company Tax identification number. For the Netherlands this is the VAT number)

Recording your story

When your account info is completed you can start preparing to record your audiobook. There are some technical specifications you have to consider:

You may want to consider buying a good microphone which will costs you from 100 euro; https://tweakers.net/microfoons/ shows one of 66 euro. If you have a quiet environment a reasonably good smartphone might just do. Important is that there shouldn't be all kind of noises added to your recording.


The quality should be at least 192 kbps with 44,1 kHz. Check the settings of your app; I use the Android/iPhone app Easy Voice Recorder in which you can set the bitrate. Also the Technical requirements of Findawayvoices say: RMS for each file must measure between -23dB and -18dB, with peak values below -3dB, and a maximum -60dB floor. This should not be a problem if you read in a normal voice. If you need to process your audio in some way, a good Pc program to do so is the free Audacity (https://www.audacityteam.org/) which also allows you to convert existing content to 128 Kbs (but bear in mind that a lower quality recording does not improve when you convert).

When you start reading, you need to have between 0,5 and 1 second of silence (called room tone) at the start and between 1 and 5 seconds at the end.

Read your text in such a way that your listeners can hear every word well enough but also enjoy listening to you. Don't talk to fast but also not to slow. Check your text for specific phrases for which you might need to make a decisions how to read it, like numbers. Your book should normally not be uploaded in one recording. The length of a recording should not exceed 120 minutes; a usual way to provide your content is to upload each chapter as a separate audio file. It is not allowed to have your book read by a computer generated voice except created by a trusted partner.

Creating your audiobook

At the left of the opening screen, after logging in in Findawayvoices, you will find the option to move to several screens/options. The small arrow on the vertical line switches from icons to text; the icons below the red Findawayvoices icon (which opens the first screen, when clicked) are My Audiobooks, Reporting, Marketing, My Account, Help and Sign Out. You maintain or add audiobooks using the options My Audiobooks, and click the green button in the right of this screen +NEW PROJECT or the link Start your first audiobooks now. Then you enter:



Metadata

This contains several screens of details. You can often find a "What is this?" link which explains you what to enter. Some entries are explained below. Also upload a cover picture. This should be a square image of 3000x3000 pixels.

It is possible (for most distributors) to set a price of 0. The site will suggest a price based on the size of your book.



Audio




Here you upload your audio files. What you need to do is make at least these four recordings separately, Opening and Closing credits, Body matter and Retail Sample. See below what it should contain and the technical requirements earlier in this document.

- 1 Read the book title, author and narrator which should be equal to the in metadata. This must be uploaded in the section **Opening credits**.
- 2 Read some closing text, like "I hope you enjoyed" and whatever you want to tell about the book, the way it was written, etc. This must be uploaded in the section **Closing credits.**
- 3 Make a summary. This can contain the blurb, usually found at the back cover of a book so the potential reader can decide if (s)he wants to buy the book. Also you can read a fragment which obviously should not give away any spoilers. This Retail Sample should not be less than 1 minute. This must be uploaded in the section **Retail Sample**
- 4 Front matter (Title page, dedication, preface, author notes, introduction) Can be left blank
- 5 Body matter This is the actual book content
- 6 Back matter (can be left blank)

Publishing your audiobook

When you have filled in everything, you can see a summary in Overview. Then you go back to the main menu My Audiobooks (the headphone icon) where you see your book(s) In Progress (or published). If anything is incomplete, it will show Metadata incomplete, clicking the question mark icon shows what is missing. Otherwise you will see a publish button making your audiobook available for quality control (technical and also some ethical requirements).



If all works out, you will receive a mail like this after which it takes 2-4 weeks before the book is available from the selected distribution partners.
